## Canada's Commissioner of Competition to Lead the International Competition Network

OTTAWA, October 27, 2006 – The Steering Group of the International Competition Network (ICN) has confirmed Sheridan Scott, Canada's Commissioner of Competition, as Chair of the Steering Group, effective February 2007. Commissioner Scott will succeed the outgoing Chair, Dr. Ulf Böge, President of Germany's Bundeskartellamt.

The aim of the ICN is to intensify cooperation between competition authorities in the globalized world. The ICN is a project-oriented and consensus-based organization, with member agencies from developed and transition economies.

Commissioner Scott, currently a Vice-chair of the Steering Group, noted the significant contributions of the ICN in promoting enforcement convergence and cooperation among competition authorities as evidenced by the practical projects undertaken by the organization. Ms. Scott is committed to continue the efforts of her predecessors to ensure that the ICN provides a practical and efficient forum for the sharing of best practices and promotion of effective competition law enforcement around the world.
